


Australian Hiring Expectations - Since 2020


Australian hiring managers expect to remain active in the upcoming quarter, despite a decline of 12 percentage points over the past 12 months.

Australian hiring managers in 7 of 8 regions expect increasing staffing levels in the second quarter of 2024, while 1 region is expecting no change





Strongest and Weakest Outlooks by Sector

The **Energy and Utilities sector** is Australia's most competitive, with a Net Employment Outlook of +35%, rising by 8 percentage points since last quarter and 11 percentage points since this time last year.



Hiring Expectations - By Country


Australia (ranked 16th) continues to rank in the top half of countries surveyed globally for its employment outlook.
