
Australian Employers reported a Net Employment Outlook of +14% Energy & Utilities employers reported the strongest Net Employment Outlook at +38%

Australian hiring managers expect to remain active in the upcoming quarter, despite a decline of 18 percentage points over the past 12 months.






Australia Employment Expectations - By Sector

Employment Outlook of +38%, rising by 72 percentage points since last quarter and 5 percentage points since this time last year.




Hiring Expectations - By Country
